



First Nations University of Canada officially opens its doors for the new Saskatoon Campus Location

November 14, 2019, Regina, SK. The First Nations University of Canada (FNU) will host an Open House on Friday, November 15, 2019 at 11:30am, to officially welcome all to the new Saskatoon Campus and Library located at #91 and #230 103B Packham Avenue.

The FNU Saskatoon Campus is now situated on the Muskeg Lake Cree Nation urban reserve. The facility will provide a learning environment for students, faculty, and sessionals that will allow for direct interaction and exposure to First Nations political and business leadership. After several years as a tenant of the Saskatchewan Indian Institute of Technologies (SIIT) at 4th Avenue South, it was time to move into our own. FNU signed a 10-year lease and has occupied the location since August 10th, 2019.

The second-floor space underwent weeks of renovation and remodeling to meet campus requirements in order to be ready for the start of the September 2019 Fall Semester. Currently, the campus has four (4) classrooms that are equipped with modern technology.
